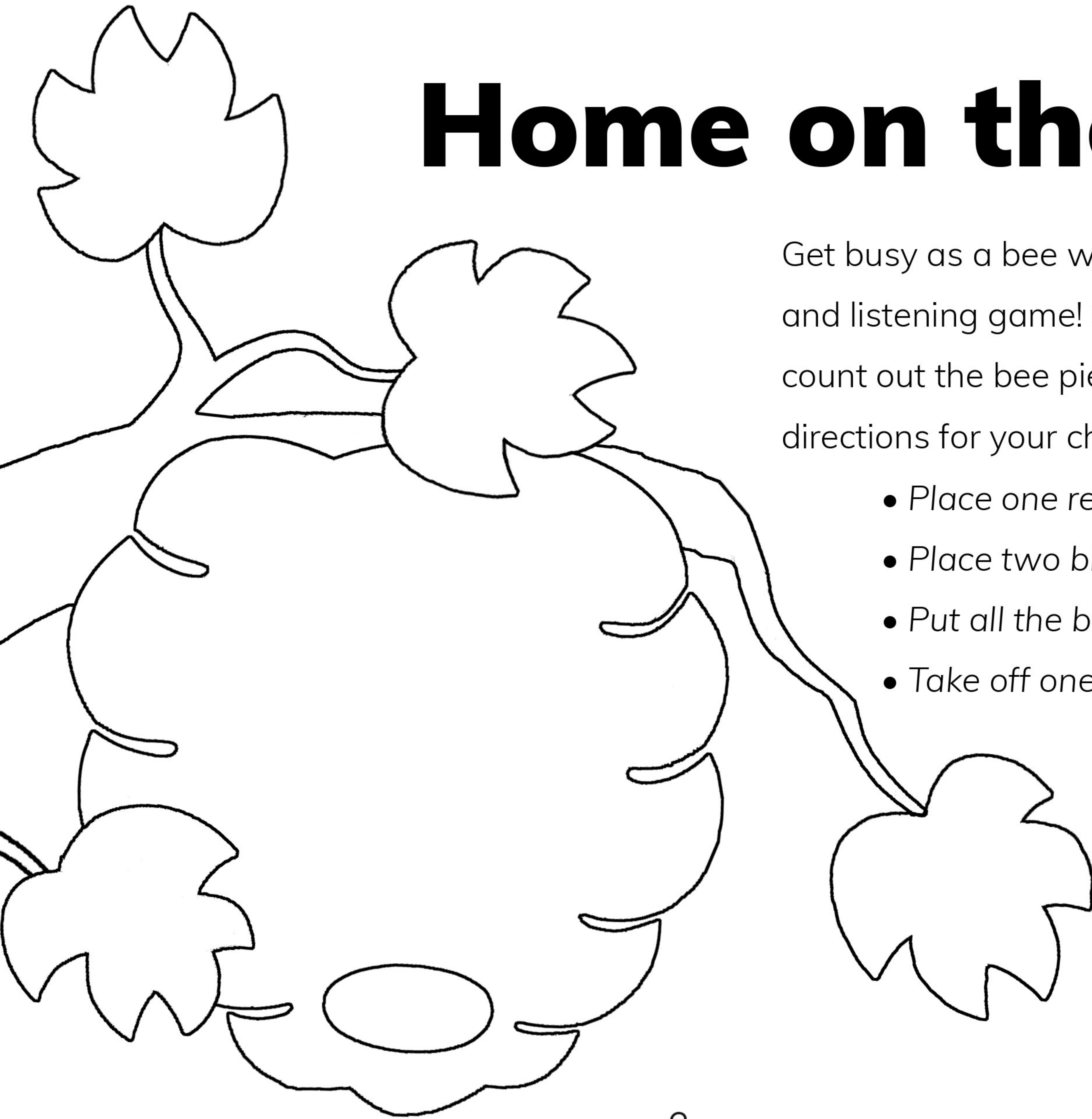

Get busy as a bee with this fun coloring and listening game! Color the bees and count out the bee pieces. Then give simple directions for your child to follow, such as:

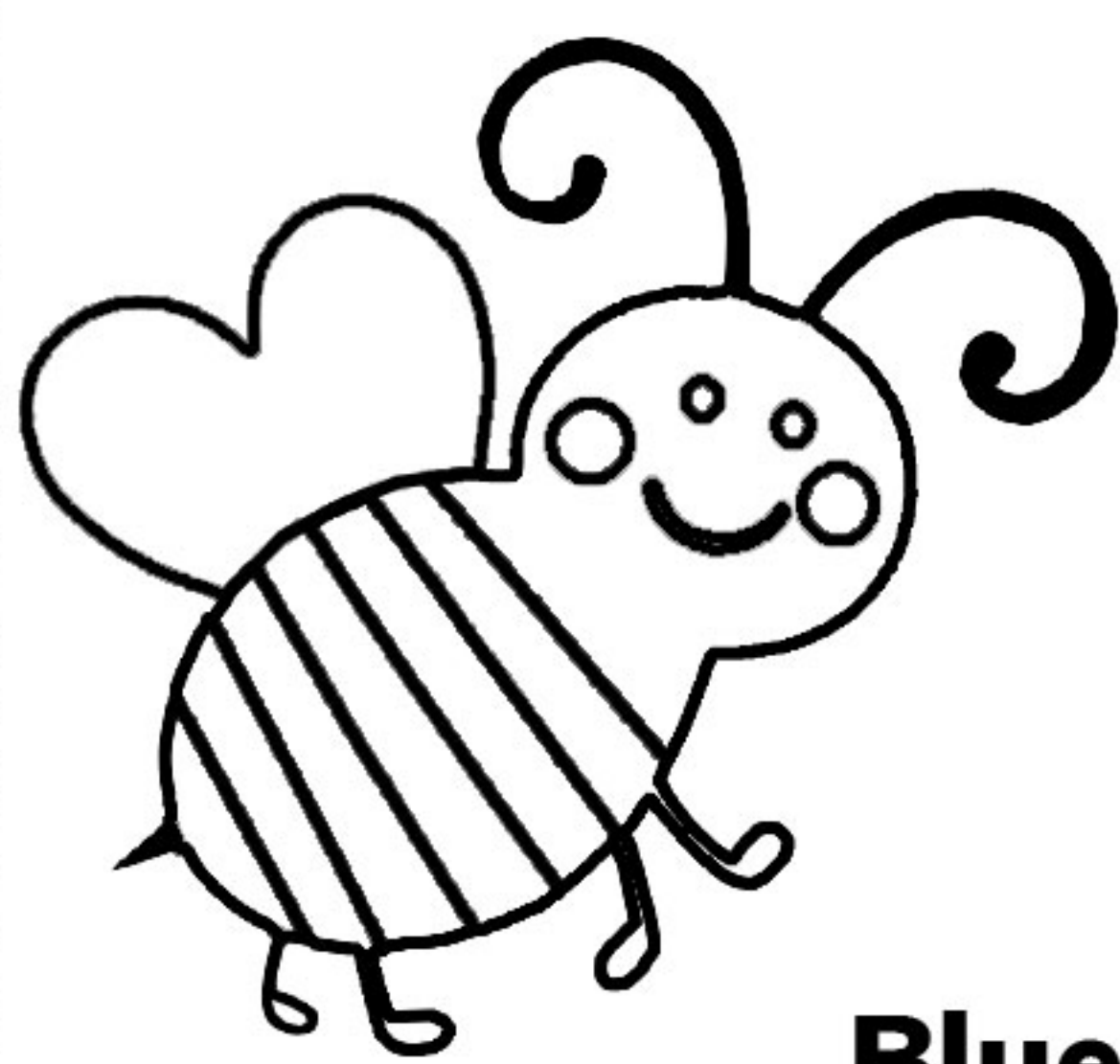
- Place one red bee on the hive.

- Take off one purple bee.



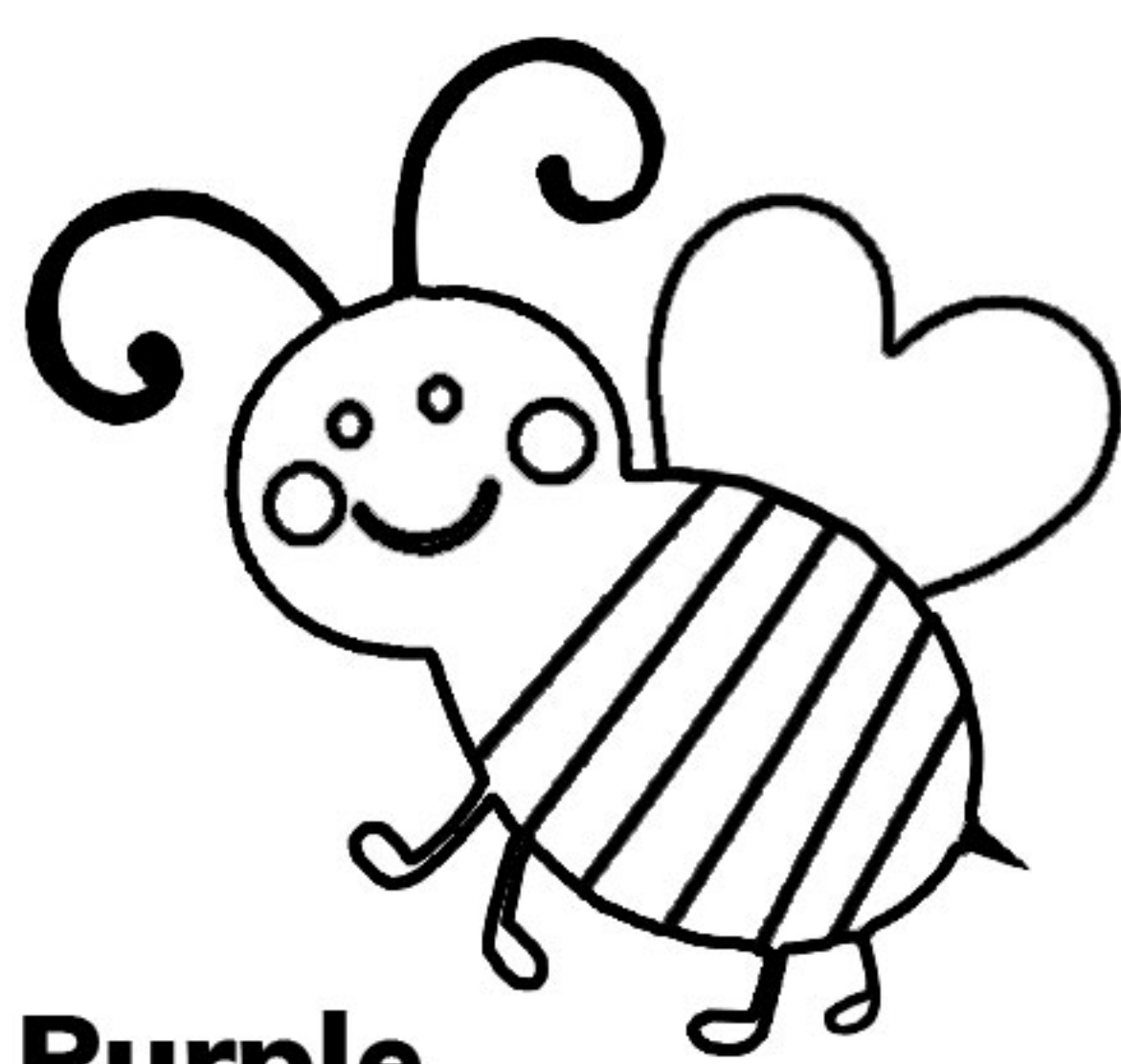

How Many at Home?

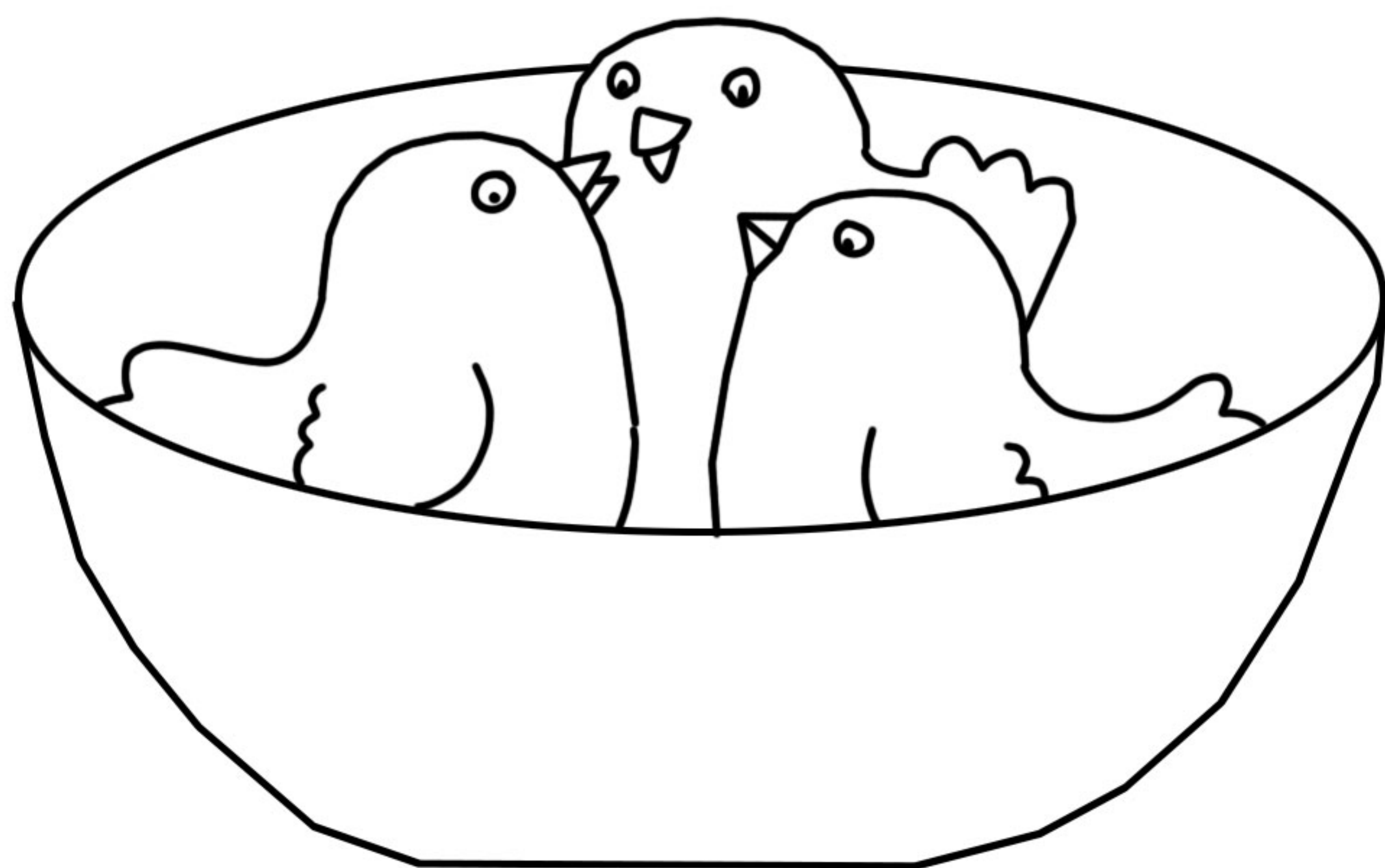
Knock-knock! Who's at home? Read the lines below to your child.

Then, trace the numbers for each animal home.



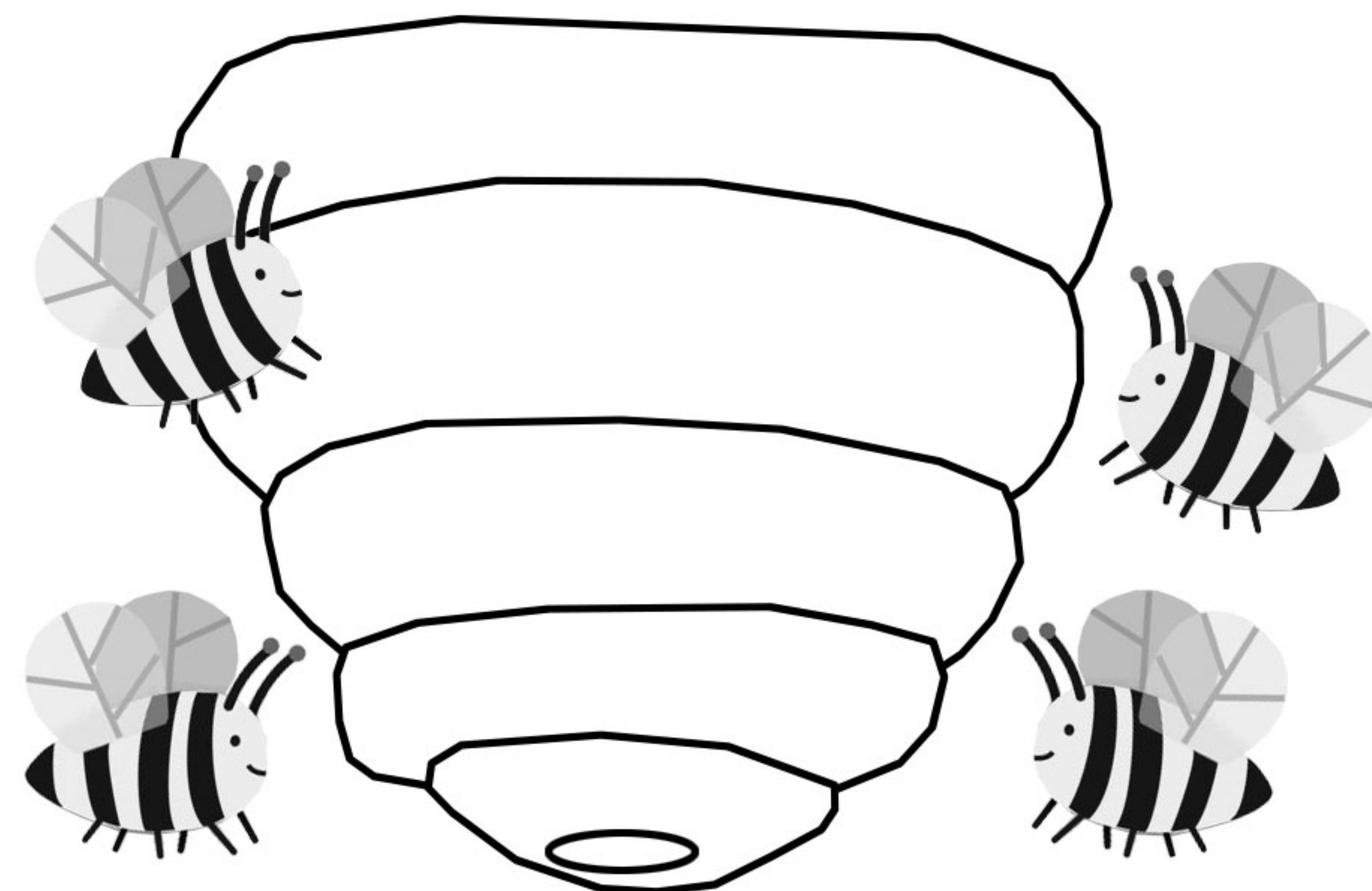
1 mouse in a hole.

3 chicks in a nest.



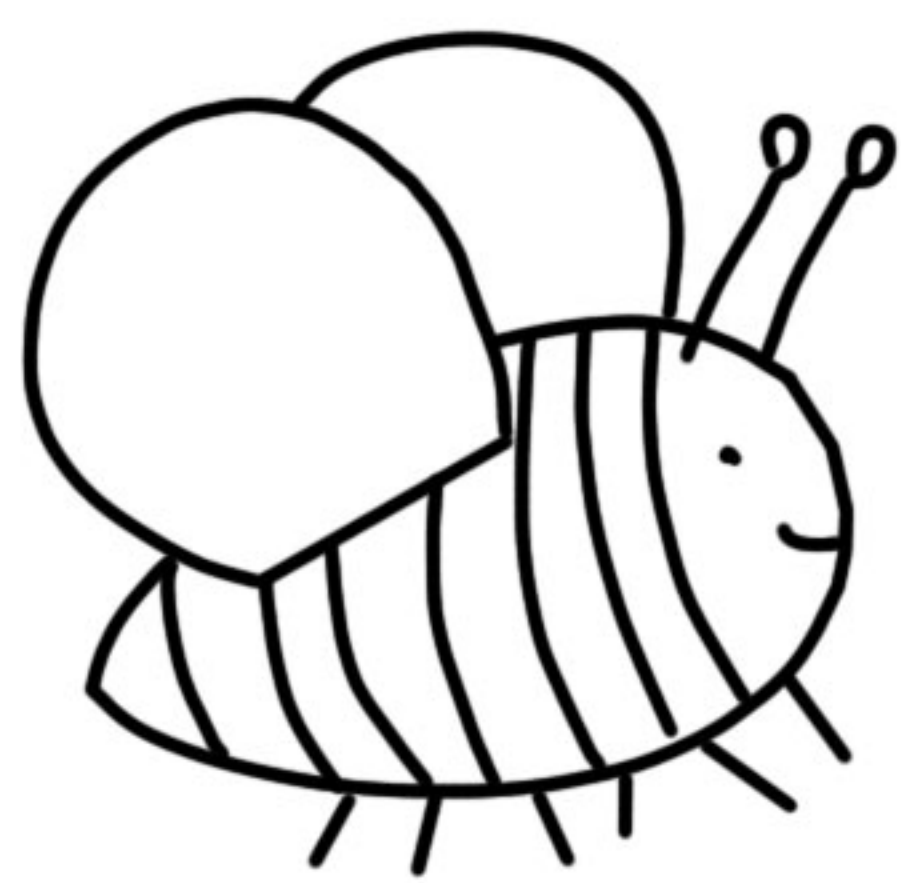

Matching Words That Rhyme

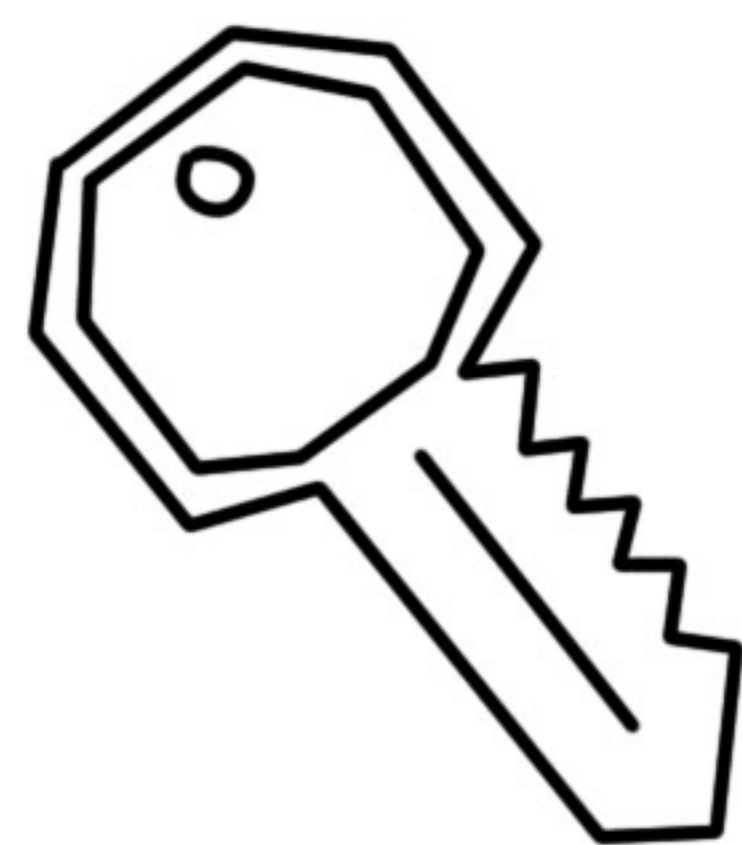
One of these words does not sound like the others!

Next, talk about each row — which words rhyme? Which one does not?

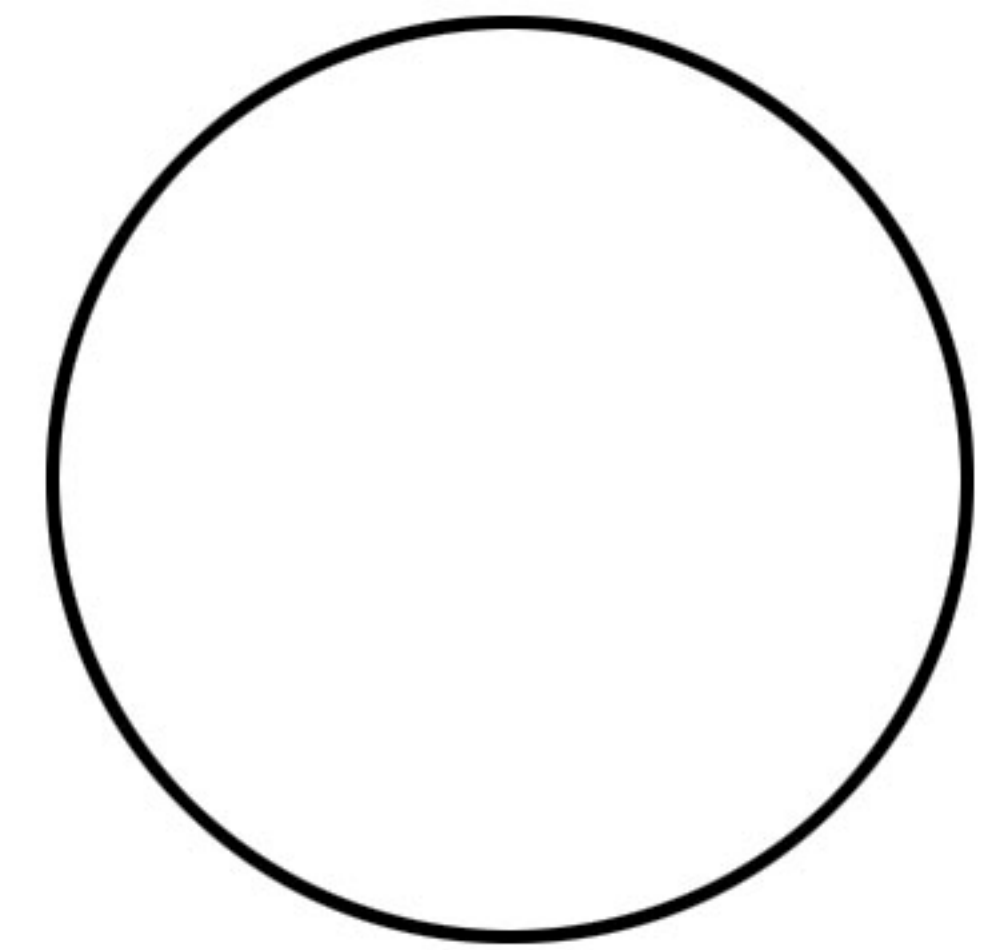

several times to hear the ones that rhyme.



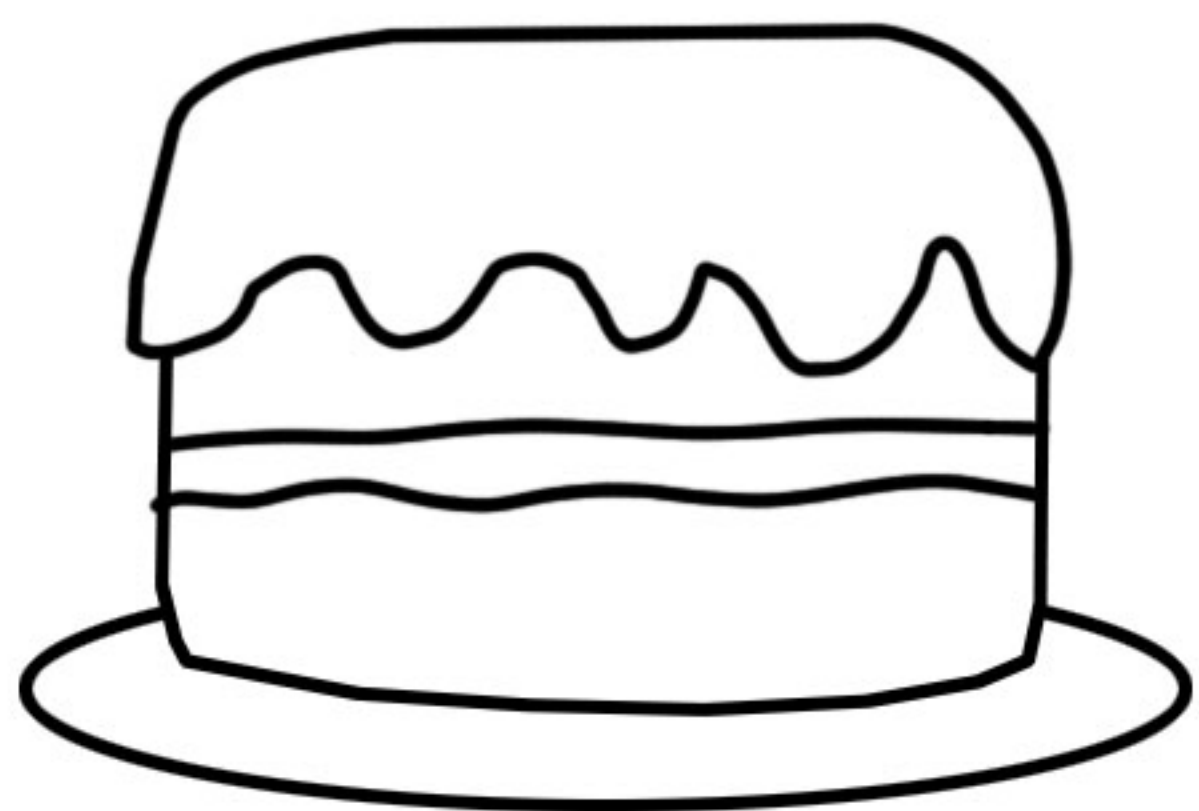
