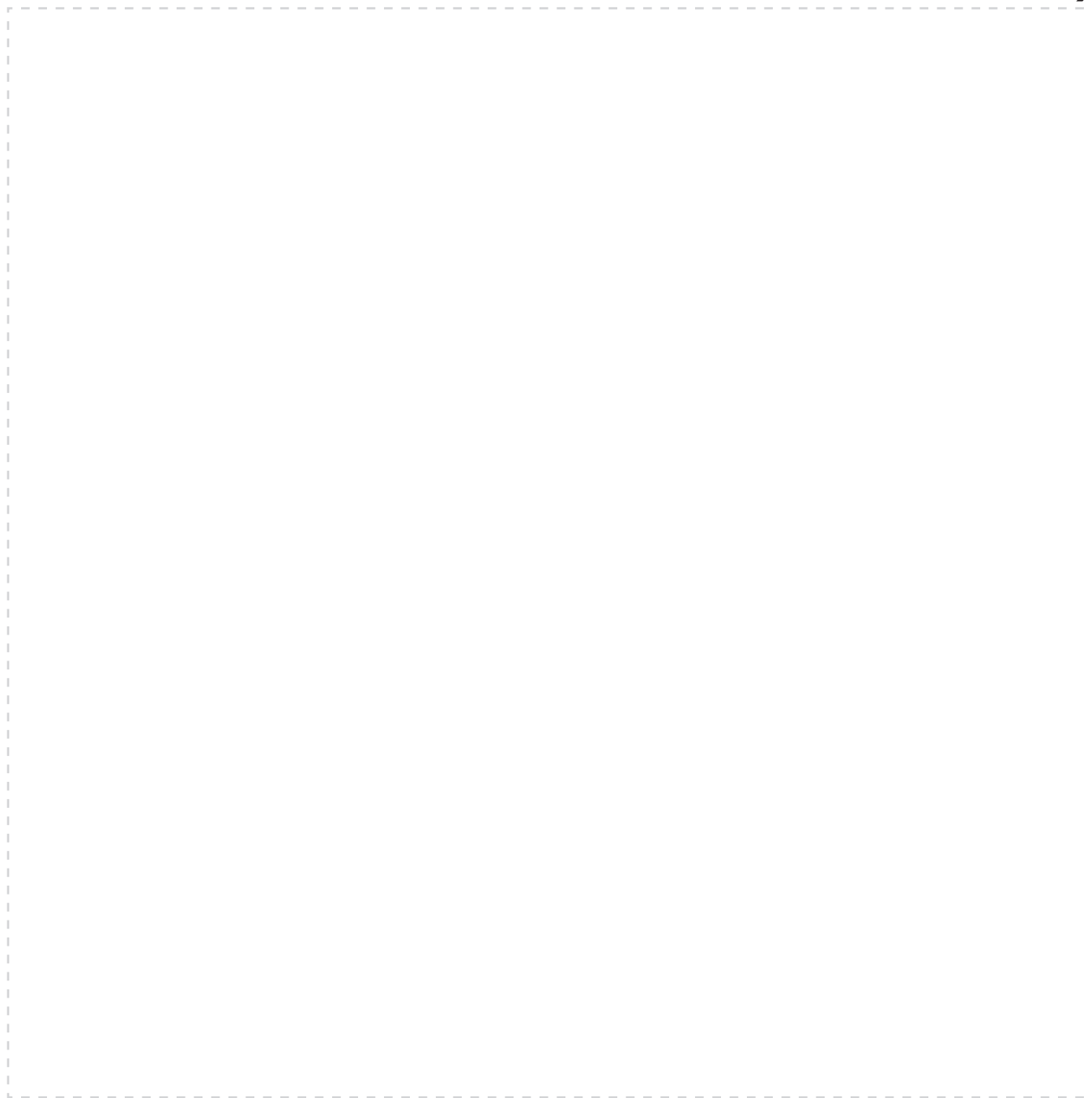


# ORIGAMI BIRD SQUARE

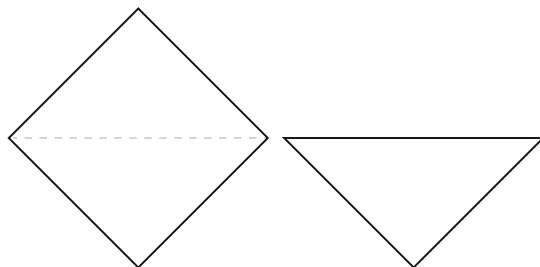
You can fold paper to make a bird!

3. Follow the directions on the next page to fold your square into a bird.

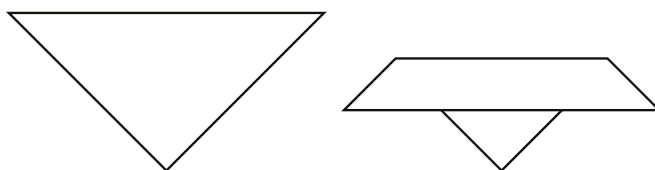


# ORIGAMI BIRD FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS

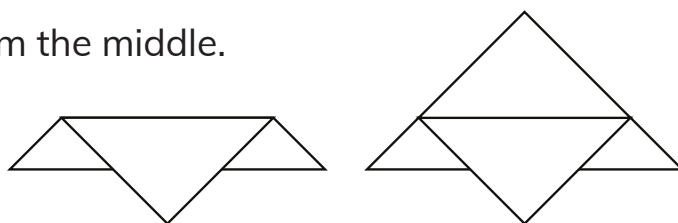
1. Fold the top point down to the bottom point.



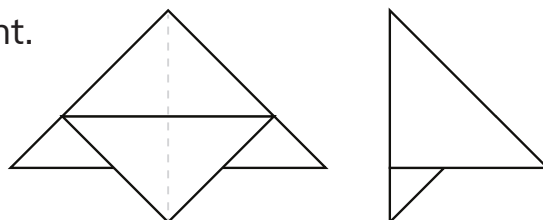
2. Fold the top edge down halfway.



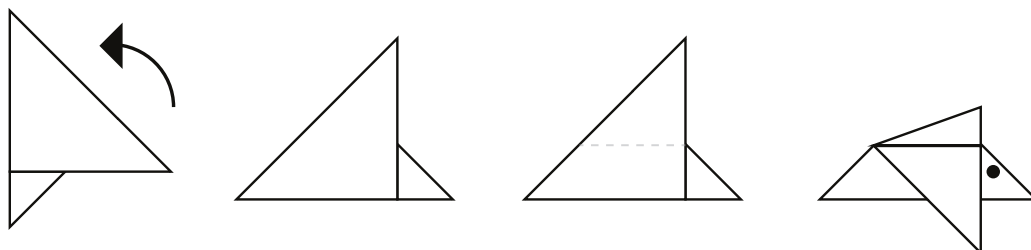
3. Flip it over. Fold the top flap up from the middle.



4. Fold the left side over to match the right.

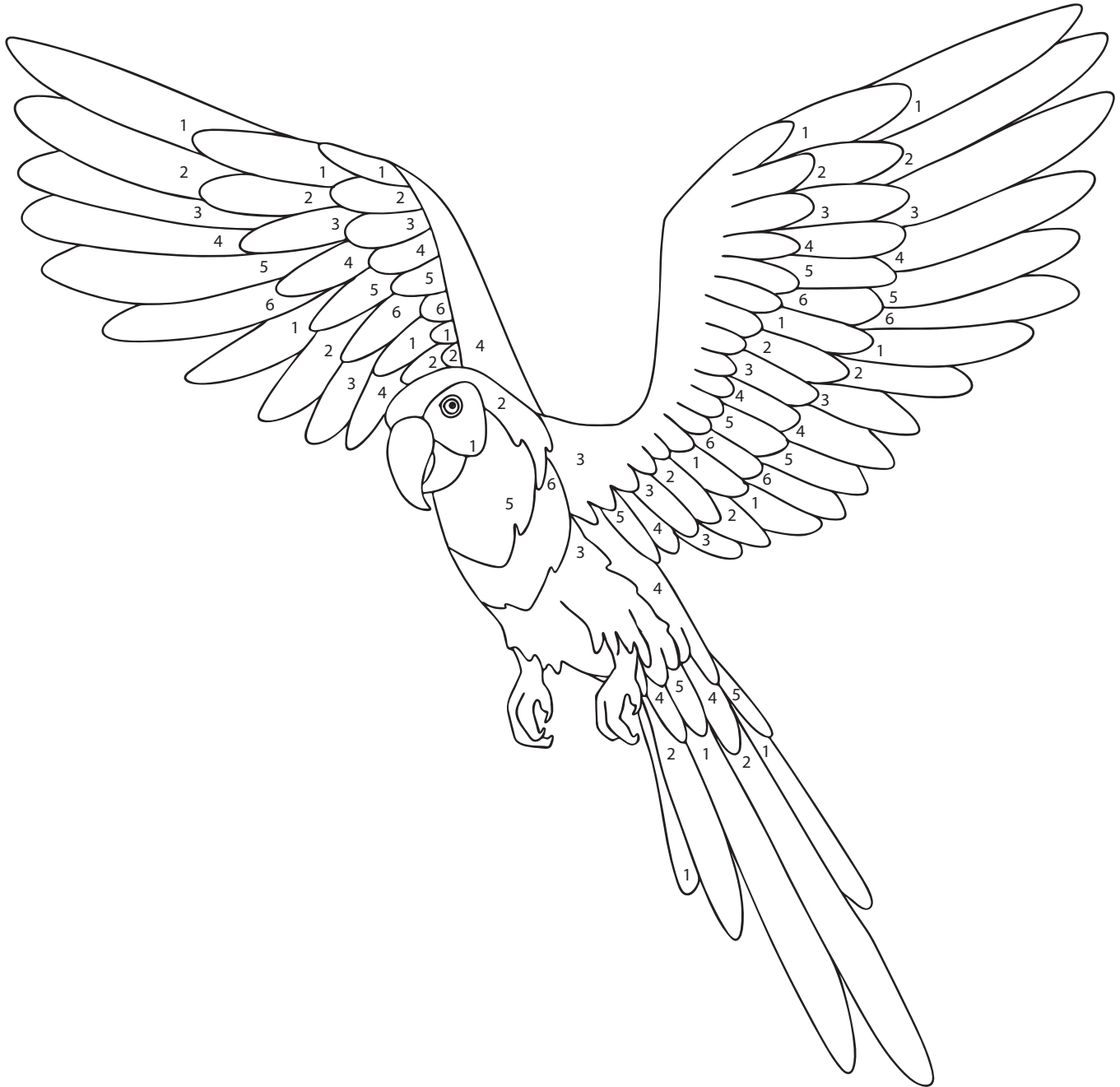


5. Turn to the left. Fold down the wings. Add an eye.  
There's your bird!



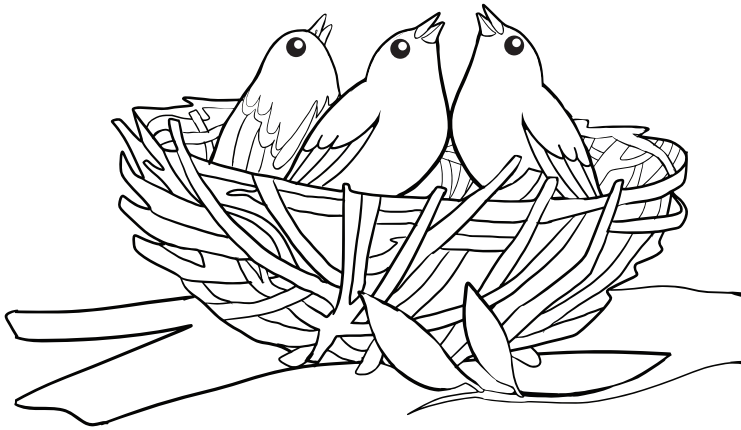
# COLORFUL PARROT

Parrots are colorful. This one needs your help! Choose six colors, numbering them 1-6. Color the feathers and other parts according to the numbers on the drawing.

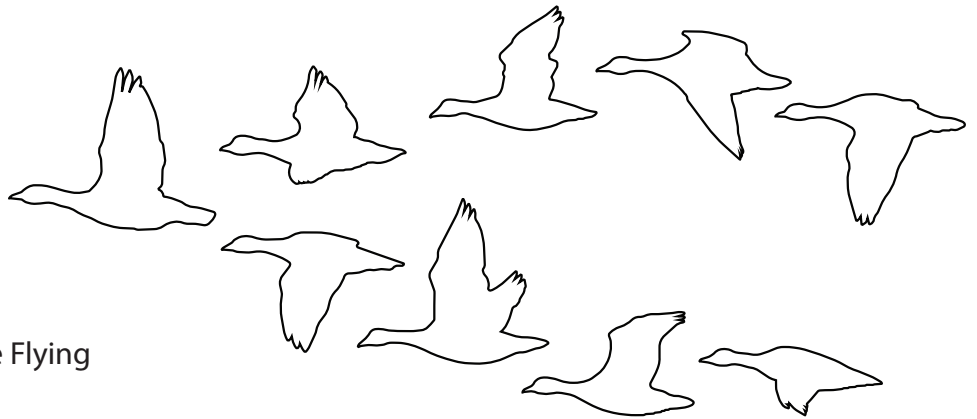


# HOW MANY BIRDS?

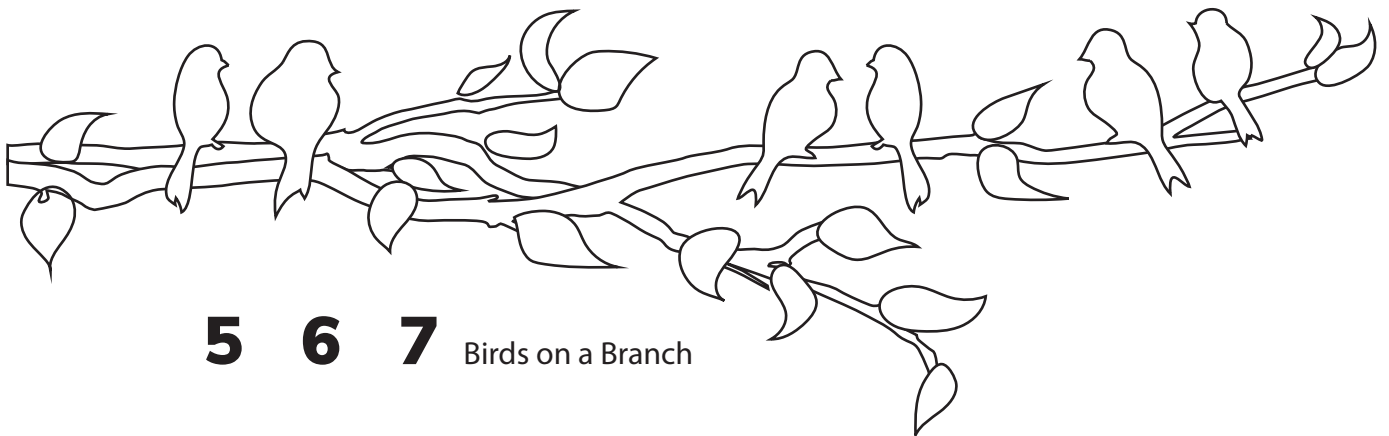
Color each picture. Count how many birds you see. Circle the correct number.
