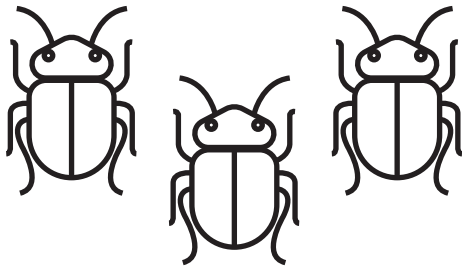


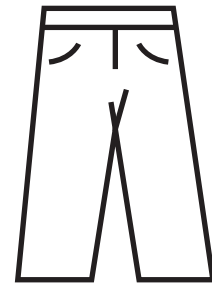

These little critters like to hide. They choose places that rhyme with their names. Color the critters and the places. Draw a line to match each critter to its rhyming place.

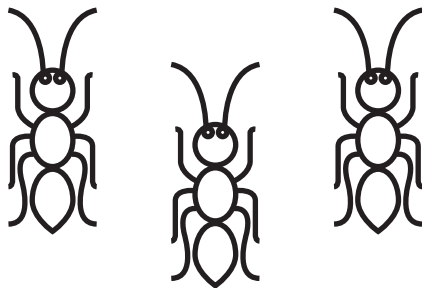
